Request for DISCLOSURE

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am scheduled to appear in courtroom #D at the Old City Hall courthouse on the 27th day of May, 2009, at 1:30pm to answer a charge of SPEEDING (Offence number: [REDACTED])

Following a request for disclosure dated February 8, 2009 and received by your office on February 17, 2009, I received a reply dated March 26, 2008 from your office to appear in order to pickup disclosure.

On April 2, 2009 I picked up the disclosure material which included 1) a single-side copy of the ticket, and 2) two short pages of notes from the officer. No other documentation was provided to satisfy the original disclosure request in full.

At this time I request that you please provide us with all relevant information not included above, gathered in the investigation of the above matter. In light of the guidelines set out in Stinchcombe, and subsequent cases, we are requesting that you include all relevant information which has been provided to the authorities, including, without restricting the generality of the following:

1. Both sides of the officer's copy of the ticket and any notes from the officer pertaining to this case. Alternatively given I've received some of this documentation above, please provide a signed letter by the appropriate authorities confirming that no other documents of this nature exist and will be used in this case.
2. For the sake of clarity, I request that the officer typewrite his notes (a copy of the notes I've received thus far has been included)
3. The make, model, and serial number of the unit used to measure the velocity of the car (radar/laser or specification of other unit).
4. Information regarding the arrangement of a sitting to review the information in the owner's manual of the above unit
5. The officer's training record specific to the operation of the unit used to measure the velocity above.
6. Any repair history of the unit used to measure the velocity
7. Records of the calibration of the unit used to measure the velocity.
8. Official procedure for radar/laser equipment testing and operator training standards.
9. All other documents that the Crown may rely on at trial.
10. We would also request that you advise us of any information available in this case, which are not being disclosed and an explanation for such non-disclosure.

If you require further information from us or have any questions regarding our request for disclosure please do not hesitate to contact me.

As I am sure you realize, I require timely disclosure in order to make full answer and defence to the charge.
